### November 2011 consumer survey

#### Consumer confidence falls back sharply in November

After picking up slightly last month, the consumer confidence indicator dropped back sharply in November. This fall brought the monthly indicator down to its lowest level since February 2010. The marked decline is undoubtedly partly due to the turmoil caused by tension in the euro area and the worsening economic forecasts.

Consumers have been taking an increasingly gloomy view of macroeconomic prospects in particular. Not only do they see the general economic situation getting worse over the next 12 months, but also their fears of a rise in unemployment have grown much stronger. Furthermore, over the past month, households have also become less optimistic about their future financial situation and their capacity to save, albeit to a limited extent.

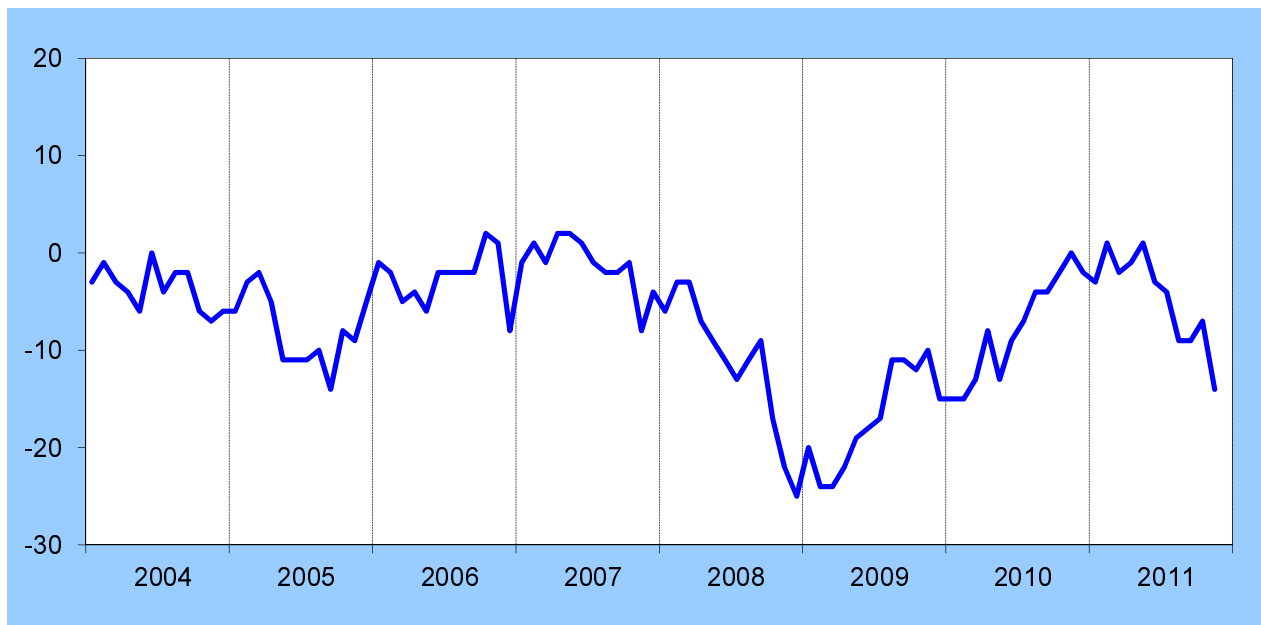

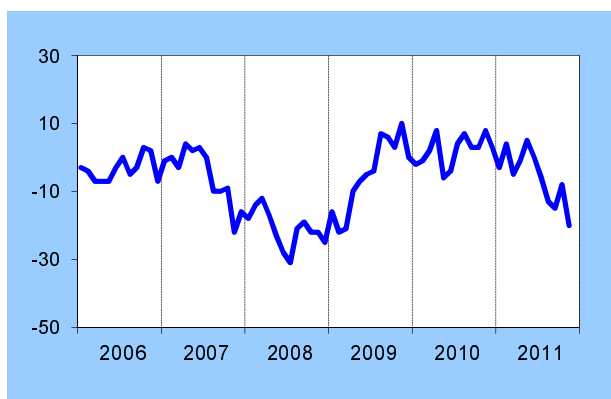

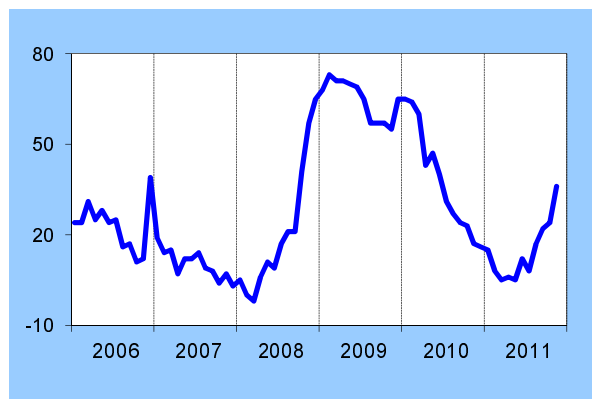


Expectations for the next twelve months

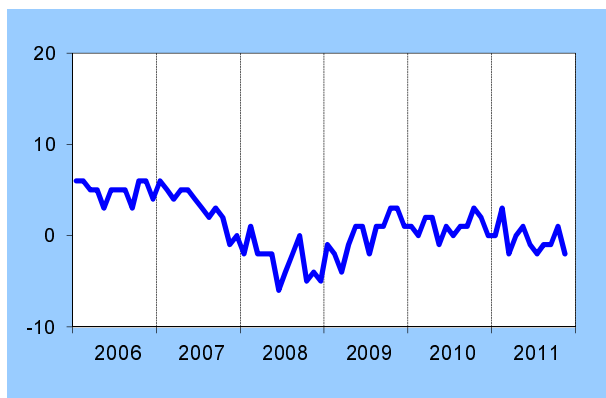
General economic situation in Belgium



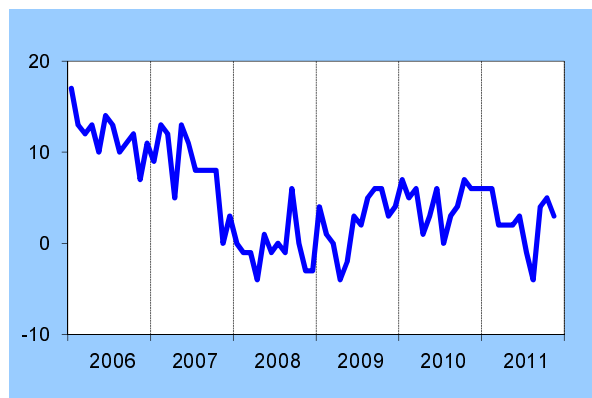
Unemployment in Belgium<sup>1</sup>
