INTERNATIONAL COMPARISON

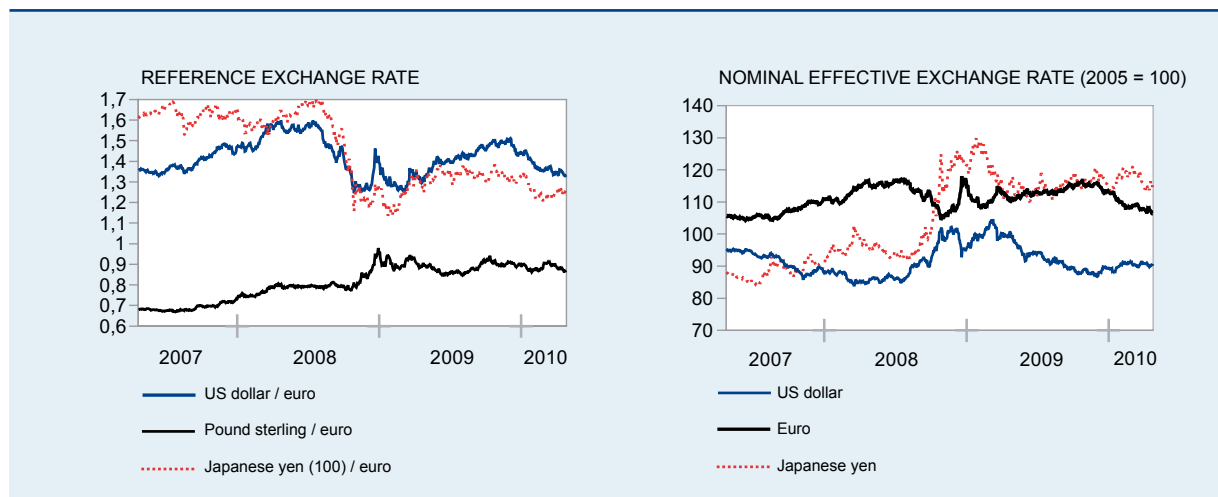

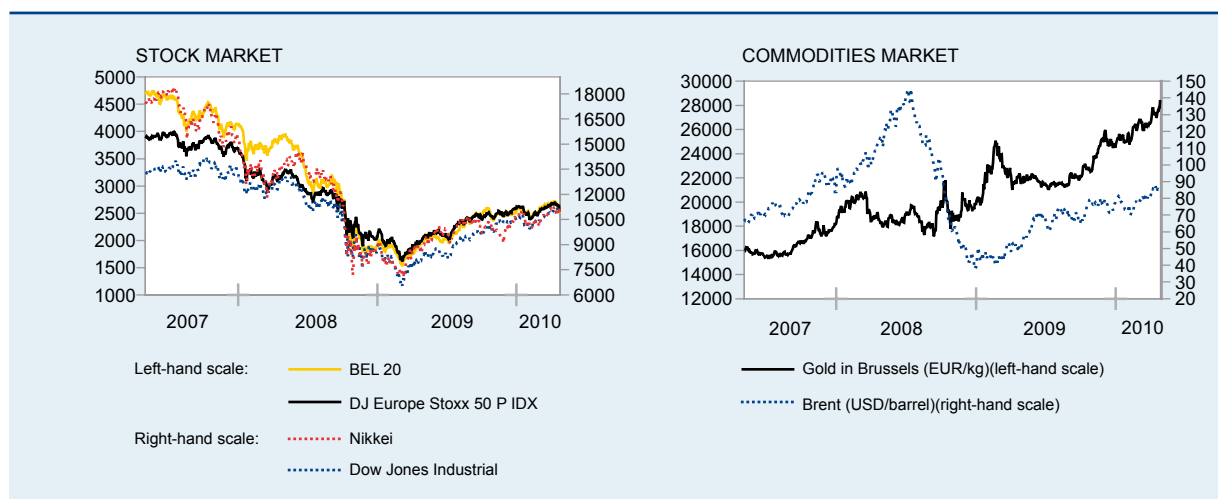
