 — Seasonally adjusted series



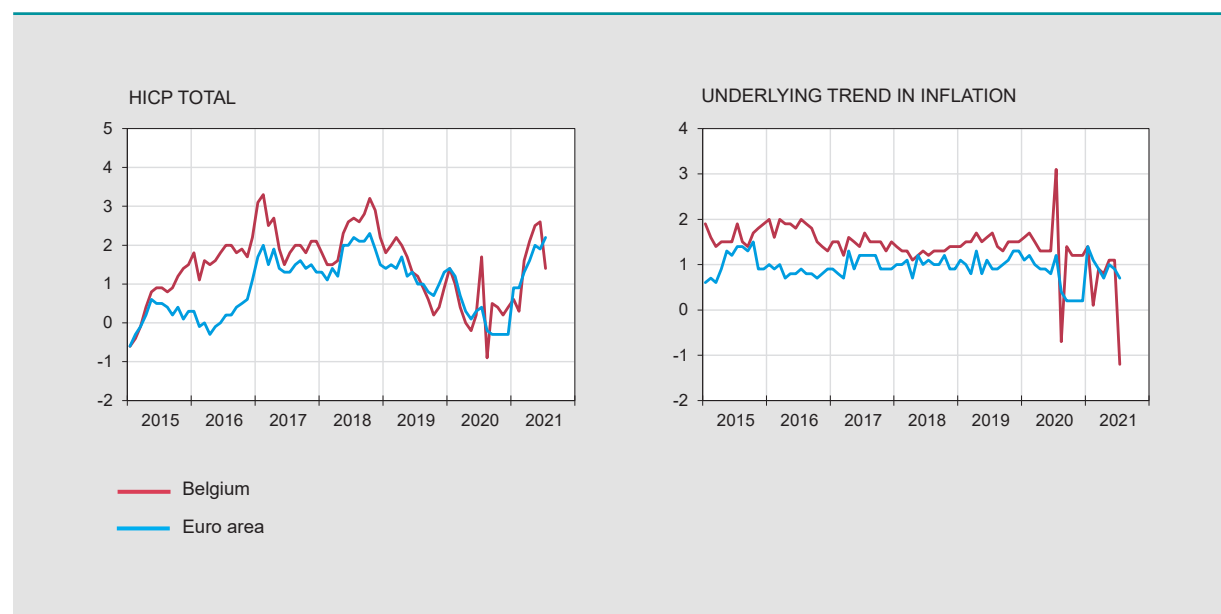

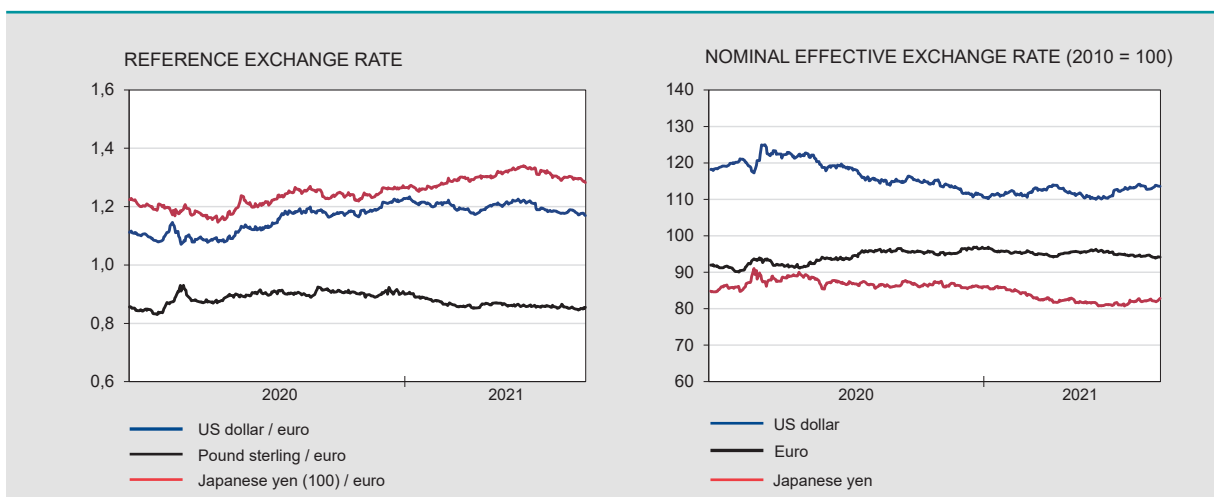

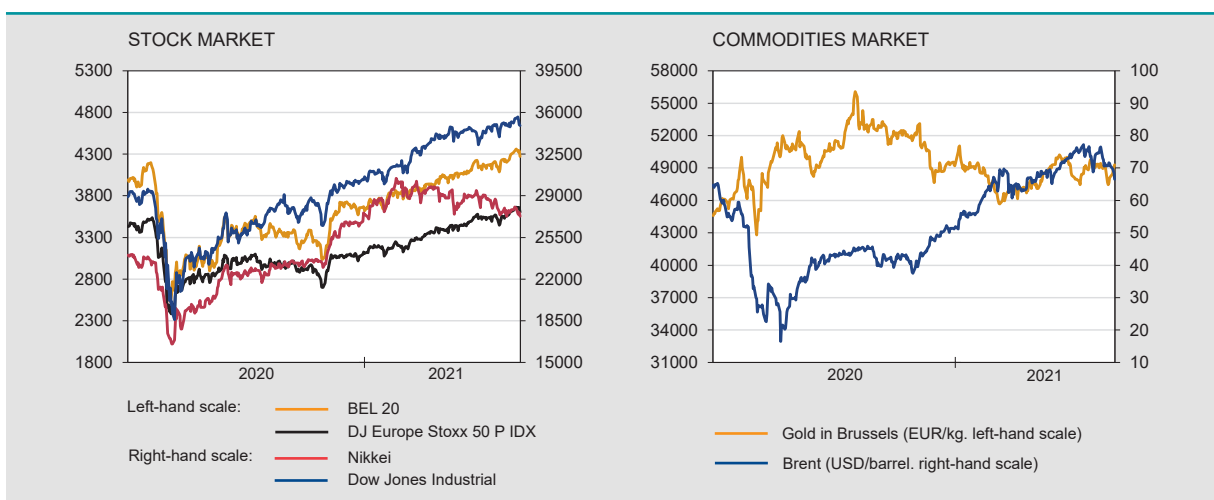
