



OVERALL SYNTHETIC CURVE⁽¹⁾




MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY

TRADE & BUSINESS-RELATED SERVICES







(quarterly data in percentage of GDP)




INTERNATIONAL INVESTMENT POSITION




