Belgian economy contracts by 0.1% in the third quarter of 2022


According to the latest flash estimate, real gross domestic product (GDP), adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, fell by 0.1 % in the third quarter of 2022 compared with the preceding quarter. The annual GDP growth rate was 1.6 %.

Pursuant to an initial estimate, value added in the industry fell sharply by 0.7 %. Activity slowed in the services sector, which nonetheless posted positive growth of 0.1 %. Finally, value added in the building industry grew at a rate of 0.3 %, similar to the previous quarter.

These estimates continue to be subject to a high degree of uncertainty, as has been the case since the start of the COVID-19 crisis and its disruptive consequences for the accuracy of estimation models. Moreover, in the absence of administrative data for September, activity was estimated using a special method. Seasonal adjustments were made in accordance with Eurostat guidelines on the subject.
