CONSUMER CONFIDENCE NEARLY STABILISES IN NOVEMBER

After last month's sharp rise, the consumer confidence indicator virtually stabilised in November.

Households did hardly or not change their expectations as to the overall economic situation, the development of unemployment in Belgium and their financial situation. On the other hand, they expect a deterioration of their saving capacity.





CONSUMER CONFIDENCE INDICATOR




Expectations on the general economic situation in Belgium over the 12 twelve months




Expectations on the financial situation of households over the next 12 months
