## **December 2013 consumer survey**

# Consumer confidence resumes very slight upward trend in December

After holding steady last month, the consumer confidence indicator recovered somewhat in December.

This month, consumers painted a divergent picture of macroeconomic developments in Belgium. They had a slightly more negative view of the general economic situation in the future. But on the other hand, as regards the labour market in particular, the fear of a renewed upsurge of unemployment over the coming year has once again worn off.

As far as their personal situation is concerned, households are expecting a very small improvement in their financial situation and their capacity to save over the next twelve months.






### General economic situation in Belgium




## Unemployment in Belgium<sup>1</sup>
