January 2015 consumer survey

Consumer confidence firms up in January

The consumer confidence indicator went up again in January, for the second time in a row. With this increase, it reached its highest level for seven months.

Like last month, both the macroeconomic and microeconomic components improved.

The consolidation of the indicator is mainly attributable to an upward revision of forecasts for the general economic situation in Belgium. At the same time, the proportion of households expecting to see an increase in unemployment over the next twelve months has come down to settle at its lowest level since October 2011.

On the personal front, consumers are regarding their future financial situation and their saving capacity a little more optimistically.

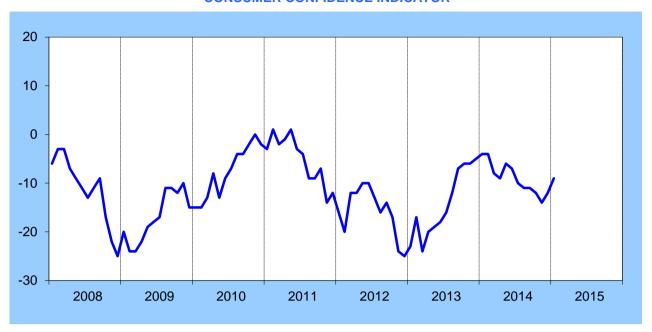

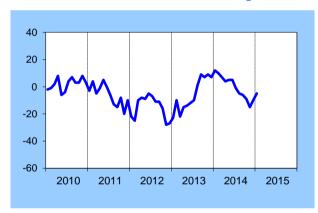

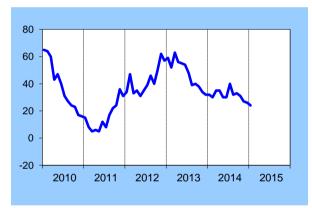


Expectations for the next twelve months

General economic situation in Belgium



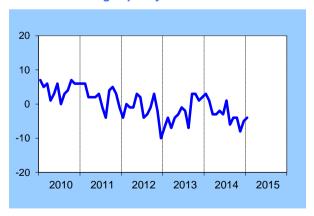
Unemployment in Belgium¹
