Monthly consumer survey - June 2023

Consumer confidence stabilises in June

- The consumer confidence indicator held steady at a level that remains below its long-term average.
- Consumers were more optimistic about macroeconomic factors but slightly more wary about their personal situation.

Following last month's slump, consumers have revised their expectations of the general economic outlook upwards, returning to April's level. Concerns about rising unemployment over the next twelve months have also waned somewhat.


On a personal level, households expressed slightly more apprehension and have revised downwards both their expectations of their financial situation and their savings intentions.






Expectations for the next twelve months
