Monthly consumer survey - January 2024

Consumer confidence wilts in January

- The loss of confidence is mainly due to a worsening outlook for the general economic situation. Households are also slightly less optimistic about their own financial situation going forward.
- Nevertheless, the indicator remains above its long-term average.

After last month's rebound, household expectations for the general economic situation in Belgium deteriorated significantly. On the other hand, consumers' opinion on the trend in unemployment over the next twelve months remains unchanged.


On a personal level, they expressed a bit more caution about their future financial situation. Moreover, they revised their saving intentions very slightly upwards.


