TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS

PAPER CHARACTERISTICS

The bills must be printed on white OCR paper weighing a minimum of 80 g/m² and a maximum of 90 g/m². The paper must not be fluorescent. If laser printers are used, xerographic OCR paper (with adequate resistance to heat and pressure) weighing a minimum of 80 g/m² and a maximum of 90 g/m² may be used.

Environment-friendly paper qualities (such as unbleached paper or paper with very low chlorine levels) may be used if the paper meets the requirements stipulated by this protocol.

INK CHARACTERISTICS

Front

- The form is printed in ochre ink.
- The ink colour used is HKS 6E, which corresponds to PMS 137.
- The headings are printed in red ink.
- The ink colour used for the wording is OCR PMS Warm Red.
- Markers for optical reading, language code and form code in black ink.
- If laser printers are used, the ink must be heat-resistant.

Frame and text: PMS - OCR - Warm Red 100 %.
