 ● Seasonally adjusted series



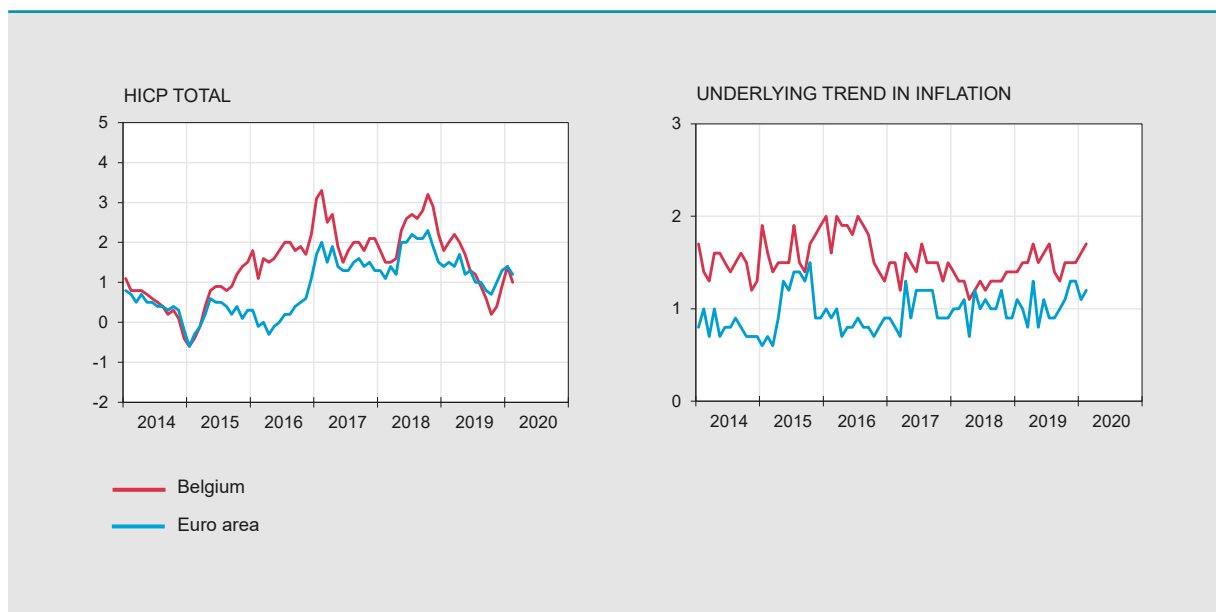

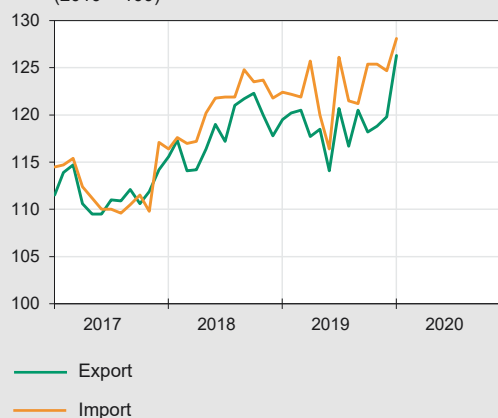

(in billions of euro)

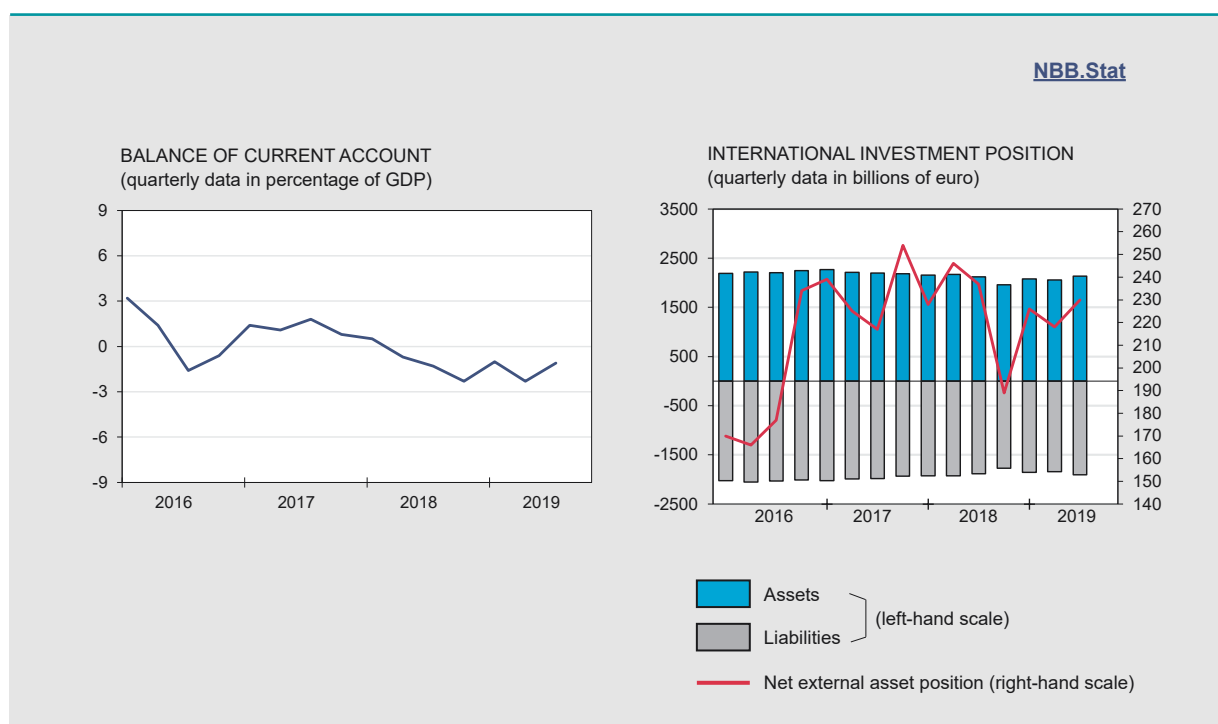

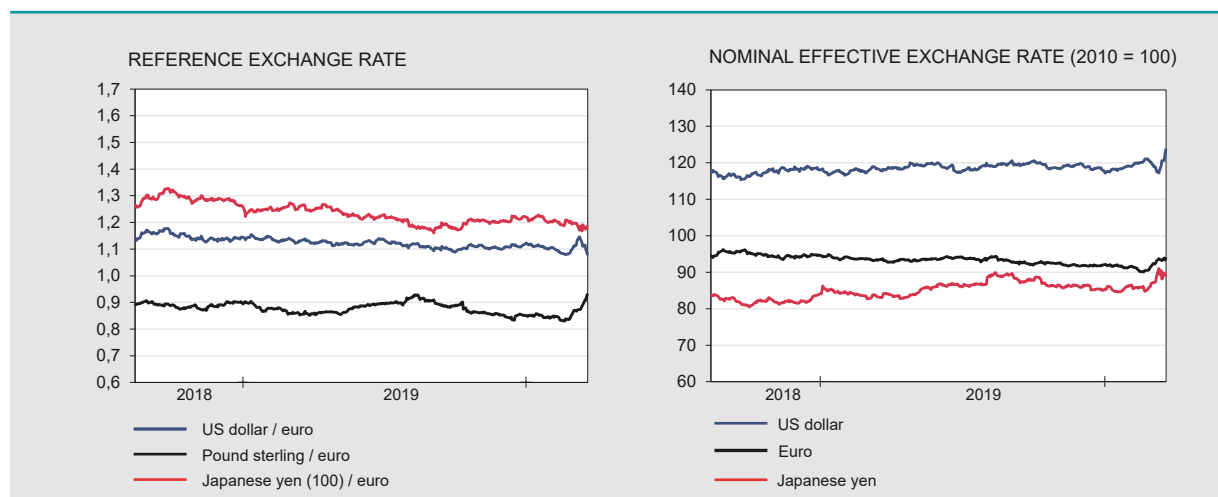

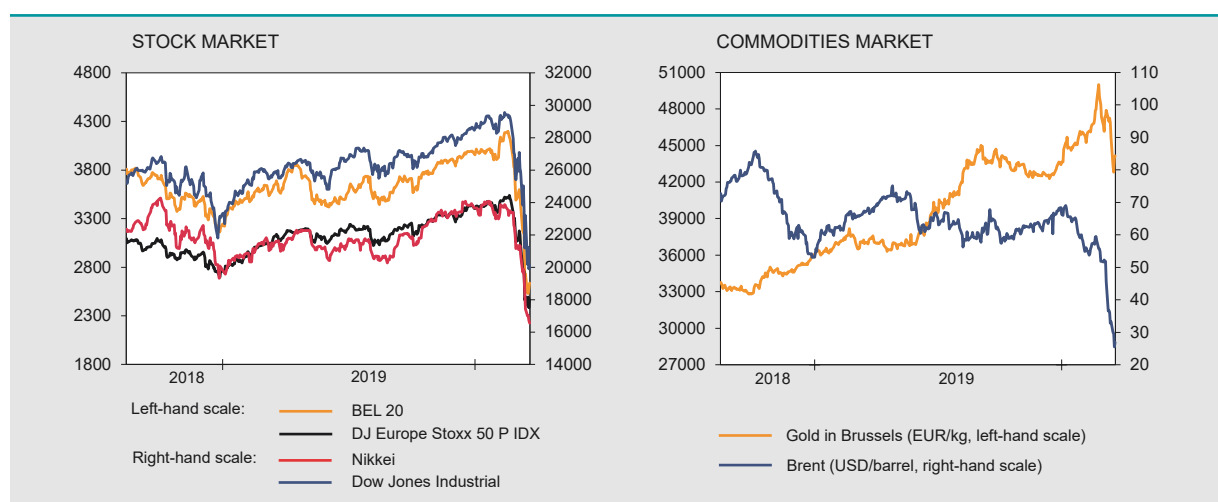
