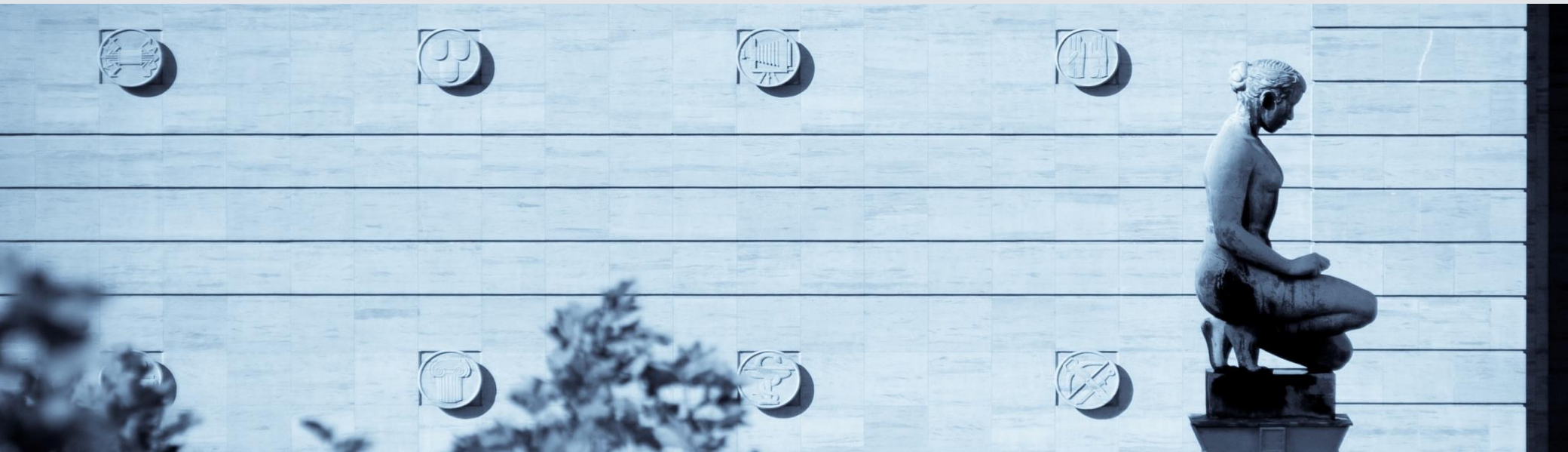

▶ Legal framework

- ECB Guideline (ECB/2014/15) and ECB Regulation (ECB/2013/43)
- Regulation binding for NCBs and reporting agents

▶ Rationale

- Increasing quality, comparability and reliability of data
- Catching evolutions in payments market
- Supporting payments policy



Setting the scene

▶ Reporting agents

- payment services providers (PSPs): credit institutions, payment institutions, electronic money institutions/issuers
- payment system operators (TARGET2-BE, UCV-CEC)
- Are no reporting agents: card schemes, credit card companies => Regulation focuses on **issuing** side of card related data
