Changes in 2020

Last year, new ways of analysing data were implemented, and the number of checks increased. This year, only minor changes have been implemented.

1. ONEGATE

The following changes have been made in OneGate.

- a. The European Central Bank adapted its validation rules and we adjusted ours accordingly. Three checks were added to table 5 (payment accounts), four cross-table comparison checks were dropped between tables 7A/8A and 7B/8B and four cross-table comparison checks were modified between tables 7A/8A and 7B/8B. These changes are highlighted in red in the list of constraints:

- b. Tables 7B and 8B have been simplified. The different parts appeared to be confusing, and some items, while theoretically possible, are non-existent in the Belgian market. In order to avoid frequent revisions after analysis, these non-existent items have been greyed out.

2. QUALITY CONTROL REPORT

We have adapted the thresholds according to last year's data. These are now more lenient for most of the items. We also added a new check to ensure that data in table 5 is reported in the right unit.

3. DOCUMENTATION

Based on the questions we received last year, we have compiled a new [Q&A](#) which is available on our website. We strongly advise you to read it carefully. Should you need more information on an item, the [methodological notes](#) are also very helpful.
