# Payments Statistics info

Reporting empty and 0 in Onegate

With this infofiche, we aim to provide clarification on reporting empty series and reporting 0 in Onegate.

**Case 1: No data to report for a certain series**

If there is no data to report for a series, we recommend not including it in your reporting table in Onegate. This way, Onegate will evaluate your reporting more efficiently.

**Case 2: No data to report for a table**

If there is no data to report for an entire table, you should use the 'set table to nihil' function to report an empty table.

**Case 3: Data to report, but not for all columns (total volume, total value, fraud volume, fraud value)**

If you have data to report for total volume and total value but no fraud volume or fraud value to report, you should report fraud volume and fraud as 0. This way, you provide us with an explicit confirmation that you have no data to report for that series.
